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REWARD AND PUNISHMENT

INTRODUCTION OF CARD SYSTEM

Dear Parents

We are introducing card system in our school to improve discipline among students and the institution in general. There will be three punishment cards (Yellow, Pink, and Red) and reward card (White). We would like you to know the functioning of these cards and require your full cooperation for the success of it. Since corporal punishment is banned in all the education institutions in our country. We observe a general decline in the discipline. There for this system not only disciplines children, but also encourages to do many good things for which they will be rewarded.

PUNISHMENT

There will be cards in place for this purpose, viz. Yellow, Pink and Red. The colour of the card changes with the seriousness of the problem from yellow to red. This cards will be issued to the offender in the school assembly which will have to be signed by the parents and returned to the office as a record. Each card is warning and when it fails, parents will be asked to take away to take their ward from the school with a red card. Please read carefully to find out when a Particular card is issued.

1. YELLOW CARD

Can be issued to a students for any of these offences :

- She/he speaks a non-campus language in the school. (Five times) (It will be based on the report of the language monitor or a teacher.)
- She/he does not do the homework. (Five times) (Teacher should have a record to prove the same.)
- When there is a serious fight when one party is seriously injured. (Once)
- Abuses others. (Three times)
- Stealing when confirmed. (Once)
- For bringing any prohibited items to the school. We presume students are well aware of it and if found with a students, repercussions will be severe. (Once)
- Bunking the class. (Two times)
- Moving out of the class while the class is on. (To drink water / toilet / medical room or to meet other teachers.) (Three times)
- For littering the class rooms and public places. (Five times)
- For being late to the class or any other venue. (Two times)
- For breaking or damaging the school property. (Once)
- For not doing the work on time. (Two time)

- For indulging in any sort of malpractice in the exam. (Once)
- Not in proper uniforms. (Two times)
- Not behaving well with the opposite sex and to the teachers. (Once)
- When boarders not report on time after the holidays. (Once)

2. PINK CARD :

Three yellow cards will enable a student to get a pink card and the possession of three pink cards will lead to a week long suspension. This will be the last warning given to a student.

3. RED CARD :

Even after two pink cards and a weeklong suspension, if there is no change in a student, it will lead to the **expulsion of the student** from the school with a red card.

4. REWARD :

A white card is a reward given to a student for the good work he / she does the school. Each card enables a student to acquire 50 point. Based on the total number of point the student will be specially honoured on the prize day. The good day work is not to be mistaken for the student responsibilities but it is more than that. Teacher will be quietly observing the student and the report will be recorded with the concerned authority. The action should be spontaneous and free. I may quote a few example here but the much more. We would like to see you growing up as good and responsible citizens in the society.

- Continuously helping weak students in studies.
- A great display of character noted by all.
- Keeping the environment clean.
- Extraordinary display of bravery when needed.
- Undying spirit to help the poor people.
